Dear Taxpayer,

This is to inform you that the Massachusetts Department of Revenue has received your Income return for 12/31/12. Your application for an extension of time to file was rejected because the Department did not have payments on the account equal to at least 80% of your actual tax due as of the original due date of the return as required. If your return was filed after the original due date, it is considered late, and you may be billed for penalties and interest including late file penalty.
